## **Background:**

OMNOVA is an innovator of emulsion polymers, specialty chemicals, and decorative and functional surfaces for a variety of commercial, industrial and residential end uses. The Global Technology Center (GTC) was built in the 1960's and expanded several times over the years. The research facility is approximately 115,000 square-feet including several labs, a paper coating test facility, and the offices.

#### **Challenge:**

The GTC has a large number of HVAC units throughout the facility. For the most part, all of the offices and research areas are air conditioned which use a significant percentage of the total GTC energy. An energy audit revealed that the GTC could save energy and money by updating and upgrading these systems.

## Solution:

By matching a grant received through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, OMNOVA replaced existing equipment, which had an efficiency rating of only about 62%, with contemporary high-efficiency natural gas solutions, increasing efficiency to a minimum of 80%. The facility also has made substantial improvements to its façade by replacing windows and roofing with high efficiency upgrades to complement the HVAC improvements.
